




Remarks for the reading of eLearning course on www.aggres.com.

As www.aggres.com has applied the pop-up windows to display the eLearning courseware in order to display the animation in full screen and it helps users to learn in a similar to real-life environment. However, as for the some reasons, the new functions of Windows XP Professional SP2 version has applied the “Pop-Up Blocker” function to block all pop-up windows, and some block Pop-up functions are also enabled in Google Toolbar, Yahoo Toolbar, MSN Toolbar and ICQ Toolbar. The steps below will show you how to allow our site, www.aggres.com, to display the pop-up windows, and the same procedures can also help you to allow any other trusted sites to display their pop-up windows.

Windows XP Profession SP2		
<p>1</p>		<p>Once you have successfully login to our website, you can click into the subject you want to study, and then click into each chapter to continue. At this moment, the pop-up windows will be shown. If in this case, there is a “Not-allowed” symbol belongs to the mouse cursor, it means your Windows XP has blocked the pop-up.</p>
<p>2</p>		<p>The first method you can do is to turn off the Pop-up Blocker.</p> <p>Go to “Tools” menu → Pop-Up Blocker → Turn off Pop-Up Blocker.</p> <p>Then, you can open the eLearning courseware.</p>
<p>3</p>		<p>If you don't want to turn off this function, you can go to Pop-Up Blocker Settings to allow the trusted site to show the windows.</p> <p>Go to “Tools” menu → Pop-Up Blocker Settings...</p>

<p>4</p>		<p>Simply type www.aggres.com in the “Address of Web site to allow” field, and then click “Add”.</p> <p>Then click “Close” to finish.</p>
<p>5</p>		<p>Now, you can click into the eLearning course, and enjoy the interactive lesson.</p>

If you are not using Windows XP SP2, but you have also experienced you can't open the eLearning courseware. One of the reason maybe you'd installed the third-party toolbar, for example MSN Toolbar.

MSN Toolbar		
1		<p>You can find the MSN logo in the Toolbar. Then, you can find the button, "Pop-ups Blocked (x)" where x means the no. of Windows being blocked.</p>
2		<p>Then, you can select "Allow Pop-ups" to allow all Pop-up windows. Or, only allow Pop-ups for www.aggres.com by selecting "Allow Pop-ups for this site".</p>
3		<p>Or, by selecting "Pop-up Guard Settings...", you can click the tab, "Allow List", and to input the website, www.aggres.com and then click "Add". Then, click "OK" to finish.</p>

ICQ Toolbar



Same as MSN Toolbar, if you installed ICQ, it will install the ICQ toolbar for you by default. So, you may experience your Pop-up windows has been blocked by ICQ Toolbar.

In ICQ Toolbar, you can simply click the “Block Pop-Ups” button once, and then it will resume all your Pop-Ups windows. No further option is provided.

Google Toolbar



Same as the above Toolbars, another popular toolbar is Google Toolbar.

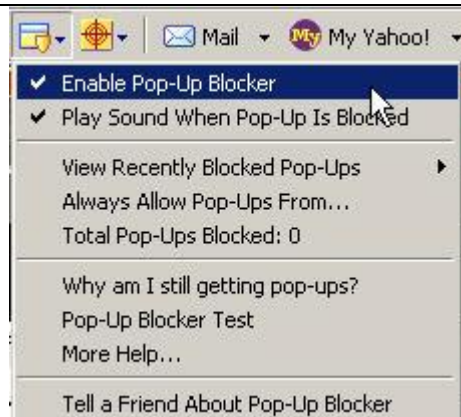
In Google Toolbar, you can simply click the “Blocked” button once, and then it will resume all your Pop-Ups windows. No further option is provided.

Yahoo Toolbar



Same as the above Toolbars, Yahoo Toolbar is also the well-known and popular one.

In Yahoo Toolbar, you can simply click the icon similar to the one highlighted in left screen. You can just click it once, and then the pull-down menu appears.



If there is a tick “ü” before “Enable Pop-Up Blocker”, that means it’s being enabled. You can just simply click it once again to disable it and allow Pop-Ups for all sites.

	<p>Another method is selecting "Always Allow Pop-Ups From..." to allow your desired website to display Pop-Ups windows.</p>
	<p>Then, you can see all the website name that blocked by Yahoo Toolbar before, you can simply click the URL and then select "Allow".</p> <p>Click "Close" to finish.</p>

For any third party tools for blocking pop-ups windows, you can also use the similar method or concept to deactivate it or add our website to the Allow List.
